Live Breaking NEWS!!!

As a Common Courtesy, horses that "**KICK**" must follow these rules.

- Have a have a red ribbon in their tail to warn others to stay back.
 - Keep the horses hind end facing a fence, trailer or other barrier between classes.
 - Leave the warm up ring immediately after the your class is completed.
- A kicking horse can be a dangerous safety hazard and your help is appreciated

The tickets that are given out to adults instead of ribbons can be exchanged for a ribbon or used at the food booth anytime this season (2008)

We had an Excellent turn out in June and we got to start on time! Due to the large classes we would like everyone to be ready when it is their turn. Memorize where you are in the list. We ask you please register as early as possible to help us start on time.

We would like to remind everyone to drive slowly coming in and going out as there are horses and people that can get seriously hurt so please drive slowly

"NOTE:" we will be calling the horses into classes in a random order for the rest of the year. This means that it does not matter what order the horses are registered for a class.

We will be randomly selecting the order the horses are going to be called in.
